What is POS Does?

Our system is an Android Tablet based serving Point of Sale tool for restaurants, coupled tightly with a management web app. The need for it arose after having to deal with clunky PC based POS systems that were not only unreliable and slow, but unbelievably expensive. Our system was the logical solution and was quickly picked up by the first restaurant we helped manage.

Expanding the team:

As of April, 2015, we are excited to announce the official launch of our closed beta open to a few select retailers and restaurants. Our goal is to finish both the Android POS app and the management web app to include the last of the features needed.

The engineering team is composed of an Android developer working on the POS app and a web architect working on the BackOffice tool. The last member is our sales leader who manages the beta released restaurants using our system, as well as a few future customers without the system.

We're looking for a part-time coder who can work with our lead Android developer in the full development of the Android POS application. The idea is to work hard over the summer of 2015 and showcase the finished product to the rest of our eager restaurants, who are as excited as we are to see the system succeed! At that point, we would have the capital to expand our team and would be offering a full-time position to our new Android developer.

Skills:

We're looking for a strong Android developer who can learn our system quickly and start work on expanding it. They would jump into the development cycle and start on feature additions. No need for POS or restaurant experience since this is a skill that can be easily picked up. They should be able to work in a team. Most importantly, since the work would likely be done remotely, they **MUST** be self-motivated, organized, and capable of working 15-20 hours a week. We hold bi-weekly scrums (though we may increase the frequency).

- Experience writing libraries and RESTful APIs
- Self-motivated and capable of working remotely
- Able to start as soon as possible
- Able to work 15-20 hours a week
